the house of bricks.

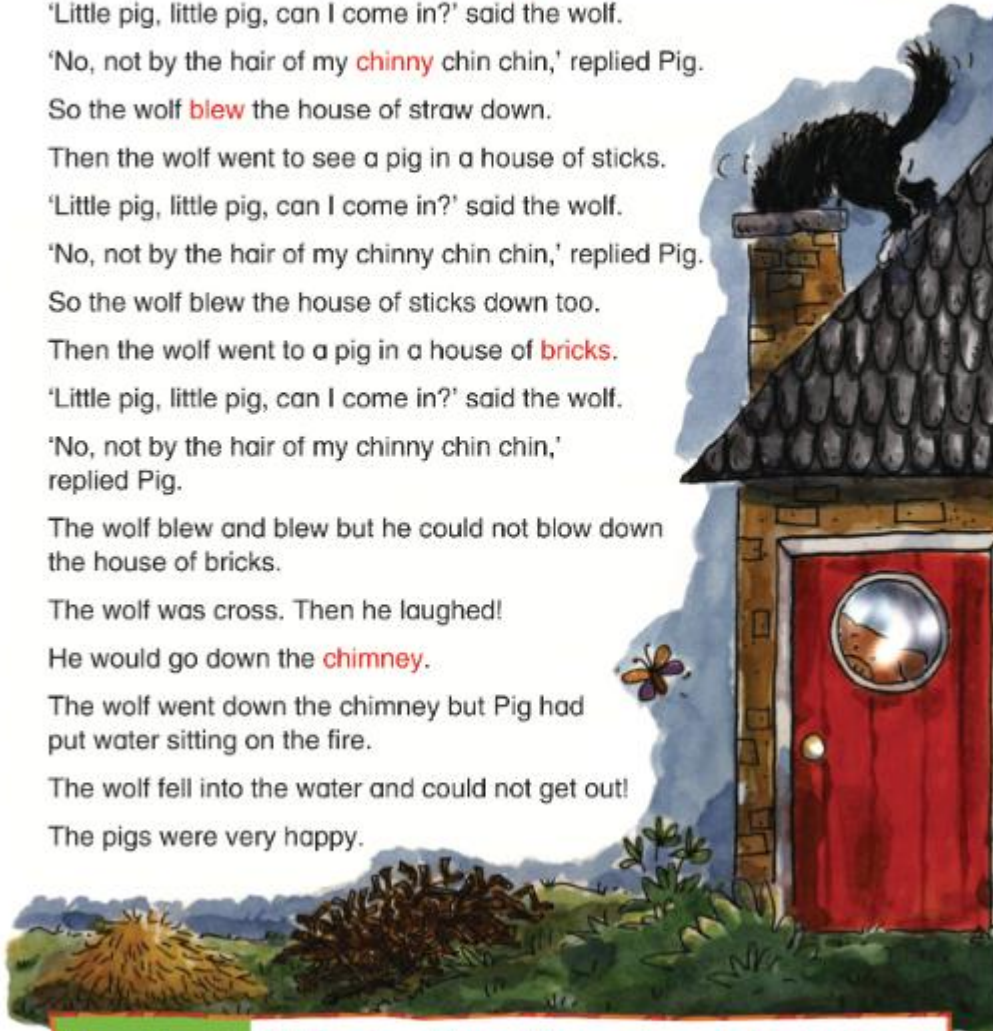
The wolf was cross. Then he laughed!
